VNC Election Deception Election Officials State "VNC Needs To Change By-Law" Election Challenge To: Stephen Box, Empower LA Election Supervisor Glen Bailey, Supervisor of Alisa Smith Alisa Smith , Senior DONE Election Project Coordinator BONC From: Rick Selan, Candidate for At-Large Candidate Fred Ceballos, Candidate for "Community Interest Officer" Re: Election Deception at VNC Election– DONE Election Officials State "Revise the VNC By-Laws." Bud Jacobs is running against Fred Ceballos for Venice Community Interest Officer. This is a separate vote; no different than President or Vice President. At the Election Forum, Mr. Ceballos debated Mr. Jacobs regarding the Community Interest Officer Election. Instead of providing a separate ballot for this specific position, VNC Election Committee under Elizabeth Wright, Ivan Spiegel, and Dante Cacace denied Venice residents and those who work in Venice the right to vote for this position. Instead , VNC Elections, who denied Venice Residents the right to vote for this position, placed Mr. Ceballos and Mr. Jacobs instead on the Community At-Large ballot with approximately 40 names. Of the 40 names, Venice Residents were only allowed to vote for "One". Rather than giving Venice residents the right to vote separately for this position, Mr. Ceballos and Mr. Jacobs were included on the list of the 40 At-Large Candidates allowing for no separate vote for this position. The by-laws do not state "At Large" Community Officer. See by-laws below. Glenn Bailey, who claimed to be the supervisor of Election Project Senior Coordinator Alisa Smith, informed four voters that while it might be less than ethical, the by-laws are the by-laws. Alisa Smith informed this candidate that DONE has been informing residents that the Venice By Laws need to be changed.

We are filing this "election deception" as a Challenge to the May 18, 2013 VNC election. The by-laws state, One (1) vote for only (1) Community Officer. This may be either a Community interest Community Officer or a Community Officer. Venice residents did not have the right to vote separately for the "Community Interest Officer". Venice residents were deceived. In unity for accountability and a fair election, Rick Selan/ Fred Ceballos
