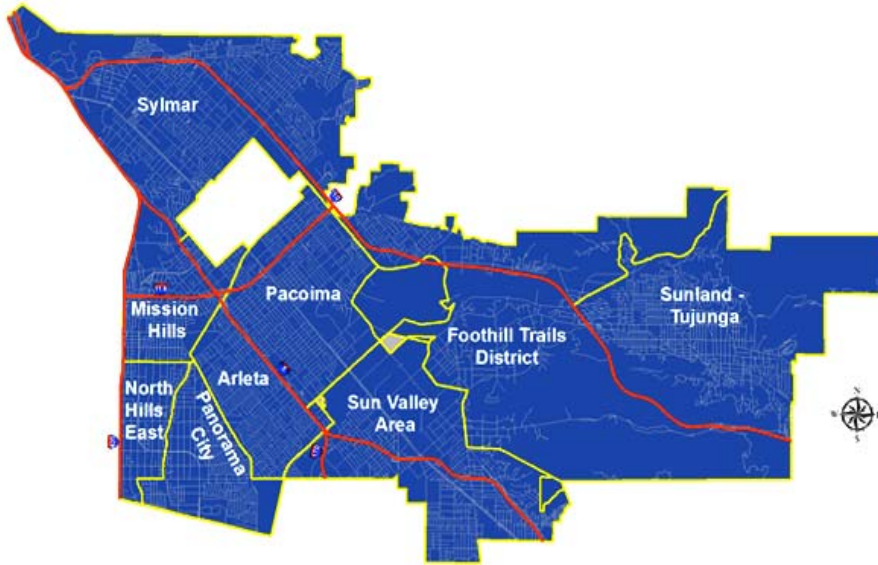

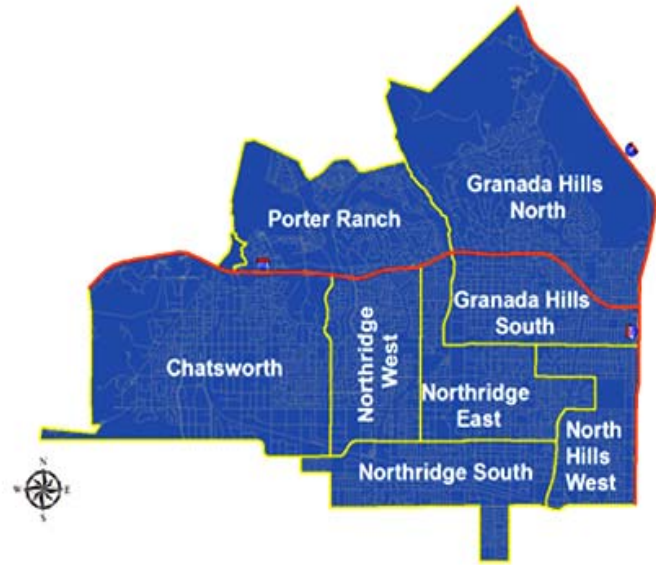

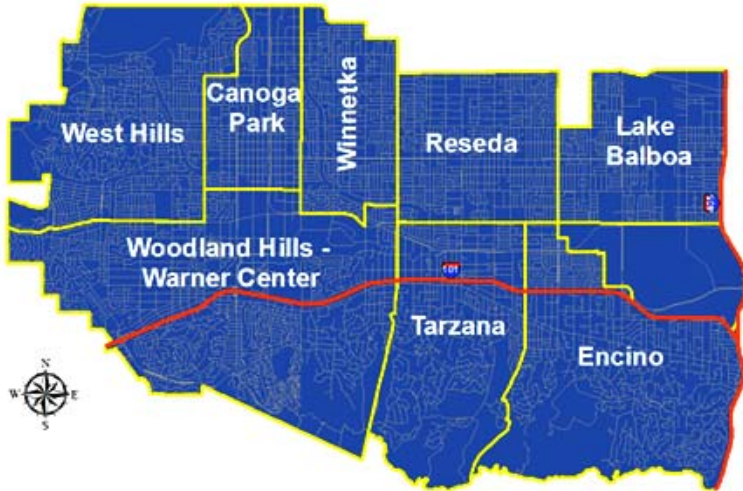
Region 1 - North East Valley



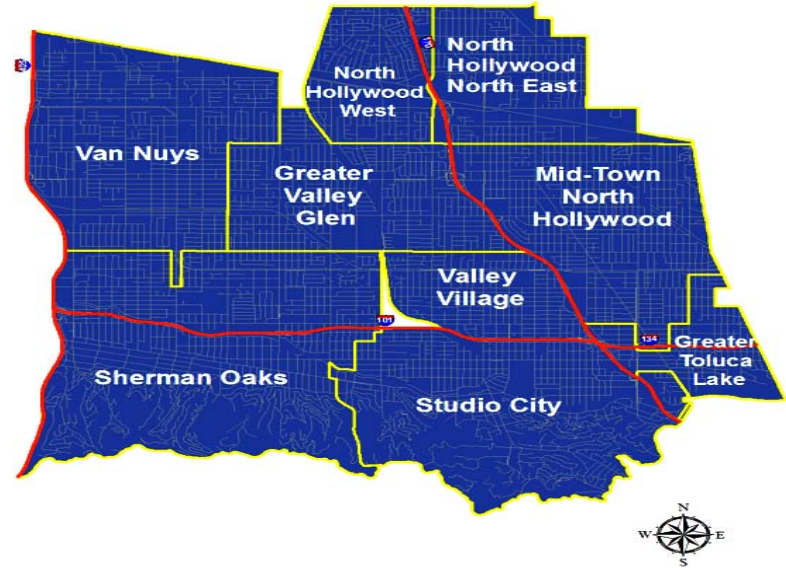
Region 2 - North West Valley



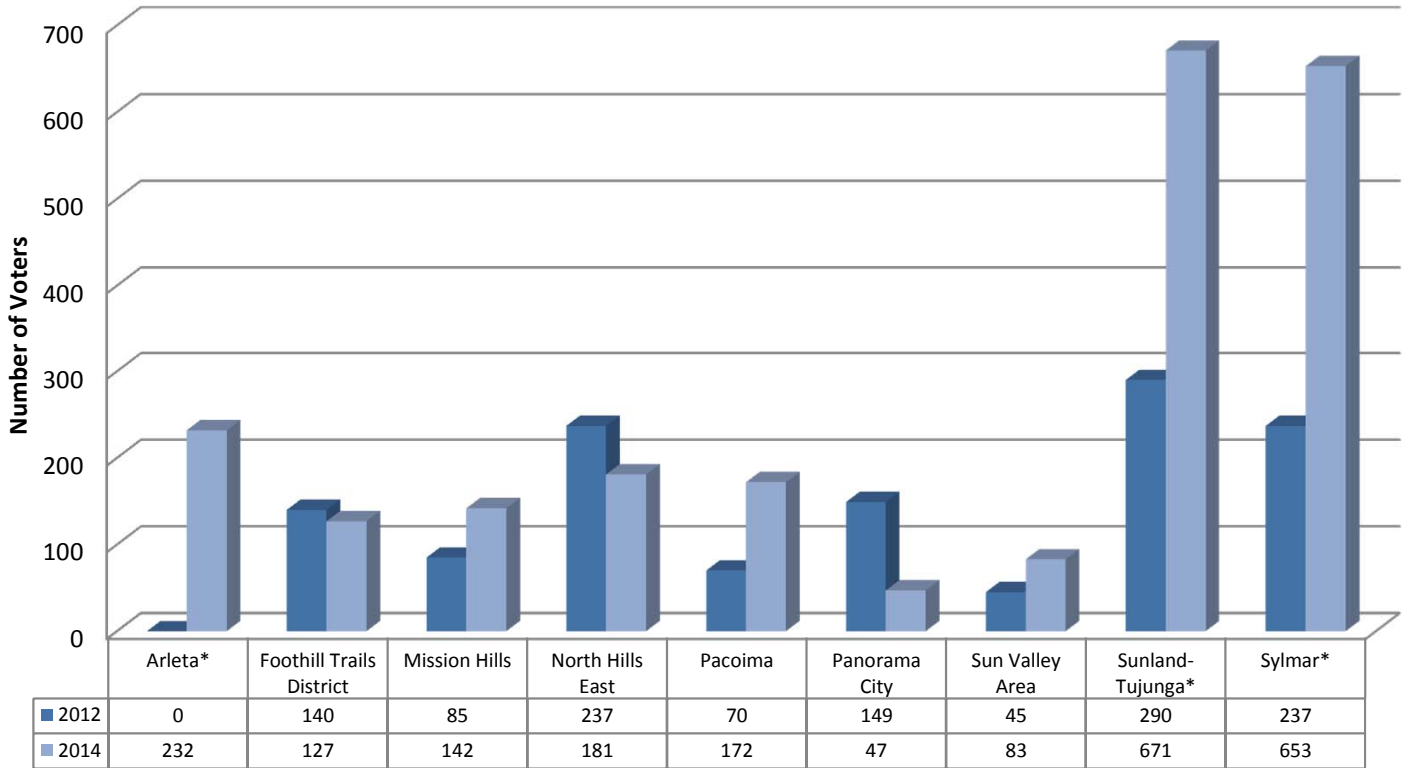
Region 3 - South West Valley



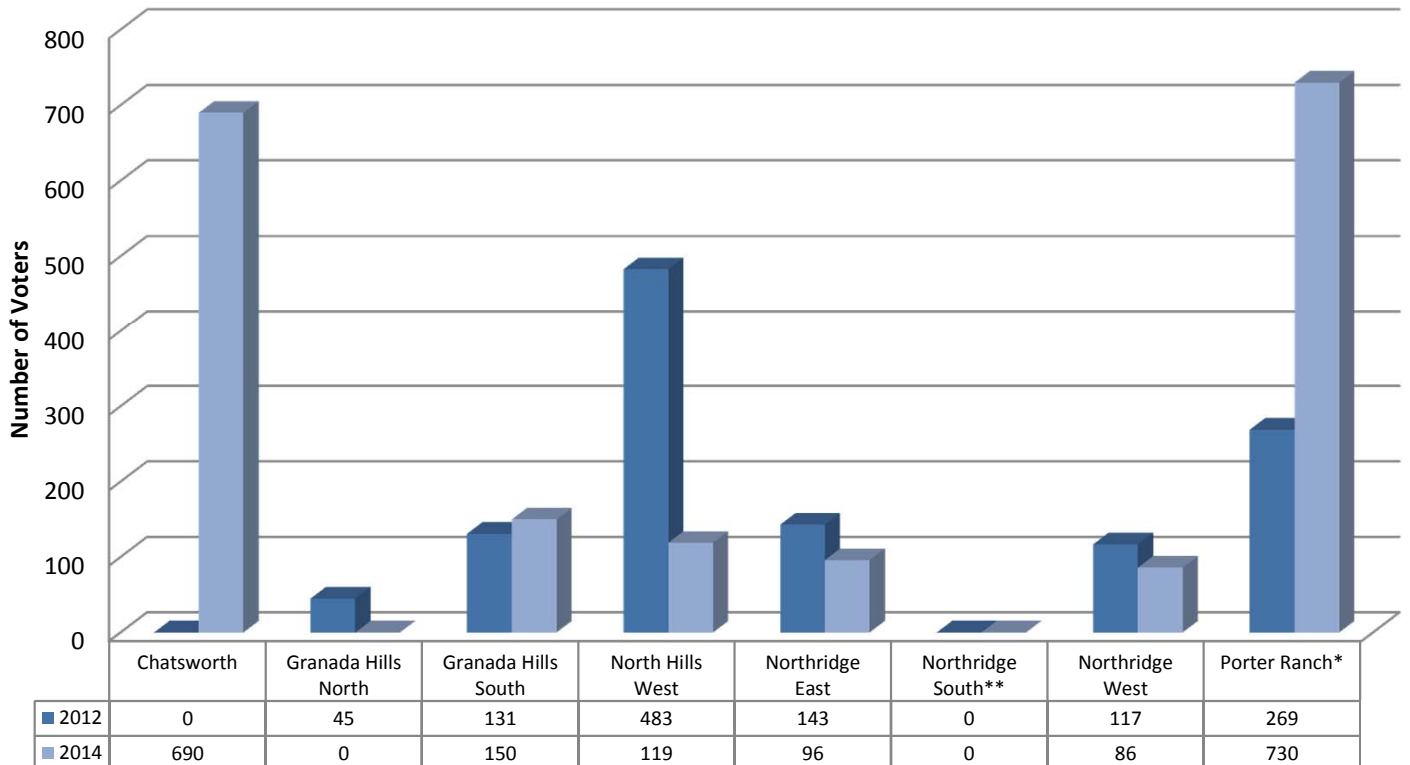

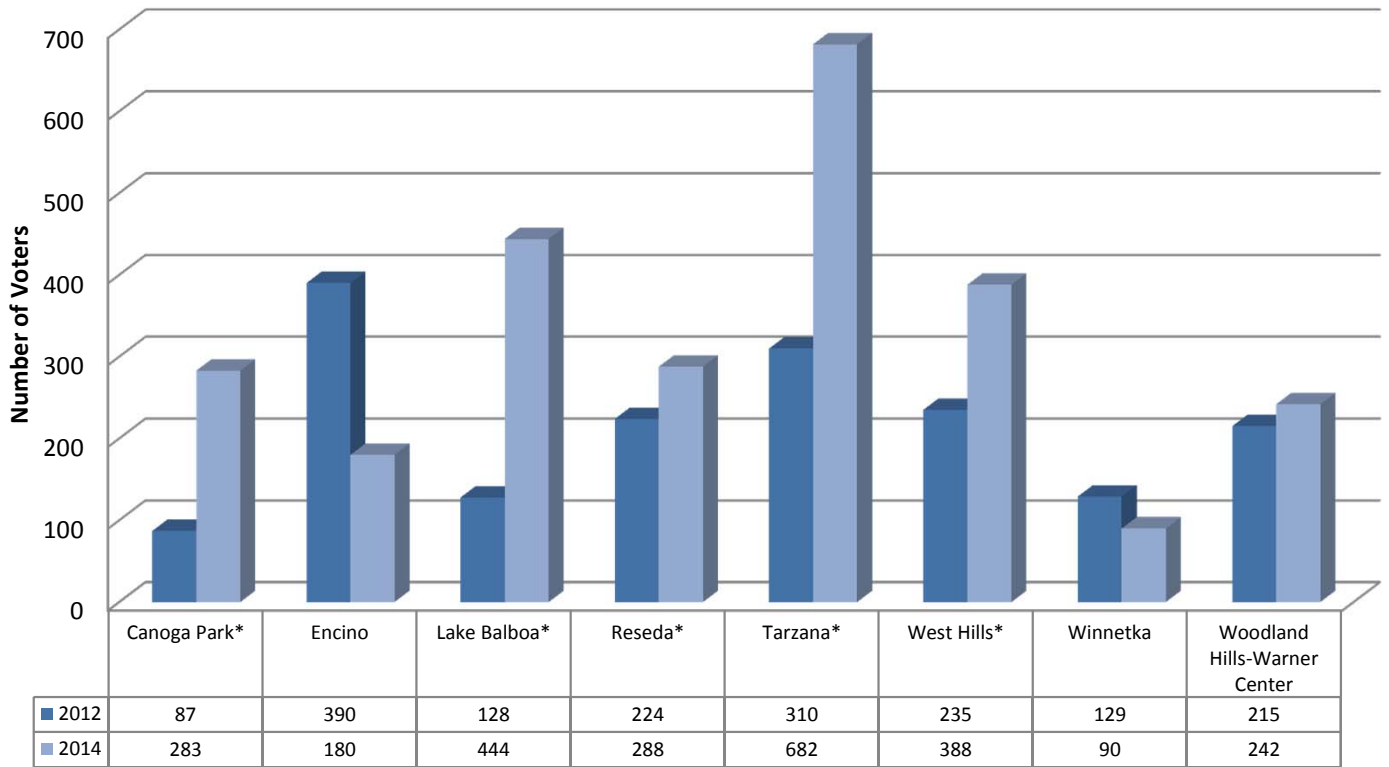
