Eligibility of Voter
I am informed and believe that as many as 140 voters were bused in and who declared themselves to be community interest stakeholders although they did not have, in fact, an ongoing and substantial participation in the Sunland Tujunga Neighborhood. For a ten year period, 2003-2012, a consistent number of from between 200 and 300 stakeholders voted. For the March 8, 2014 election over 600 ostensible stakeholders voted, without any corresponding increase of any kind: no increase in population or geographic area, no expansion of outreach, etc. The inexplicable mushrooming of votes cast can only be due to manipulation of stakeholder voter registration and voting.
The factual basis for the claims of community interest stakeholder voters, those who have no other basis for eligibility should be investigated and those whose claim is spurious removed from the count of votes for those candidates.
