Arroyo Seco Neighborhood Council (ASNC) Ballot Voting Model

The ASNC Ballot Voting Model has five (5) ballot types. Stakeholders can claim one (1) stakeholder status and be issued one (1) ballot.

1) HERMON REPRESENTATIVES BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property or who declare a stake within the Hermon geographical area and affirm an ongoing and substantial community interest and who are 18 years or older, can vote for the following races:

- Hermon Representatives Vote for up to two (2)
- Retail, Wholesale, and Services At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Faith-based Organizations At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Environment At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Education and Youth At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Recreation, Culture, and the Arts At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Healthcare and Seniors At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Community Non-profits At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Community Interest At-Large Representatives Vote for up to two (2)

2) MONTECITO HEIGHTS REPRESENTATIVES BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property or who declare a stake within the Montecito Heights geographical area and affirm an ongoing and substantial community interest and who are 18 years or older, can vote for the following races:

- Faith-based Organizations At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Environment At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Education and Youth At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Recreation, Culture, and the Arts At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Healthcare and Seniors At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)

- Recreation, Culture, and the Arts At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Healthcare and Seniors At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Community Non-profits At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Community Interest At-Large Representatives Vote for up to two (2)

4) MOUNT WASHINGTON REPRESENTATIVES BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property or who declare a stake within the Mount Washington geographical area and affirm an ongoing and substantial community interest and who are 18 years or older, can vote for the following races:

- Mount Washington Representatives Vote for up to four (4)
- Retail, Wholesale, and Services At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Faith-based Organizations At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Environment At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Education and Youth At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Recreation, Culture, and the Arts At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Healthcare and Seniors At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Community Non-profits At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Community Interest At-Large Representatives Vote for up to two (2)

5) SYCAMORE GROVE REPRESENTATIVES BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property or who declare a stake within the Sycamore Grove geographical area and affirm an ongoing and substantial community interest and who are 18 years or older, can vote for the following races:

- Sycamore Grove Representatives Vote for up to two (2)
- Retail, Wholesale, and Services At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Faith-based Organizations At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Environment At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Education and Youth At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Recreation, Culture, and the Arts At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Healthcare and Seniors At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Community Non-profits At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)
- Community Interest At-Large Representatives Vote for up to two (2)

Summary:

- The ASNC has 21 Board Seats. All 21 are elected.
- Stakeholders will use **Self-Affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is 18.
- The ASNC has five (5) voting districts.
- The ASNC Board has a two-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one Board seat.
- A stakeholder can vote for their respective geographical area plus the At-Large Representatives.
- ASNC shares public facilities boundaries with four other NCs: Greater Cypress Park NC, LA-32 NC, Lincoln Heights NC and Historic Highland Park NC.
