

Atwater Village Neighborhood Council (AVNC) Ballot Voting Model

The AVNC Ballot Voting Model has one (1) ballot type.

AVNC BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property or declare a stake in the NC and affirm a factual basis for it who are 16 years or older can vote for the following races:

- North Atwater Resident Representatives – Vote for up to two (2)
- Central Atwater Resident Representatives – Vote for up to two (2)
- South Atwater Resident Representatives – Vote for up to two (2)
- Business Representatives – Vote for up to two (2)
- Community Group/Non-profit Representatives – Vote for up to two (2)
- Church/Religion Representatives – Vote for up to two (2)
- School Representative – Vote for one (1)
- Parks & Recreation Representative – Vote for one (1)

Summary:

- The AVNC has 17 board seats. Only **14** are elected.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is **16**.
- The AVNC Board has a two-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one board seat.
