Boyle Heights Neighborhood Council (BHNC) Ballot Voting Model

The BHNC Ballot Voting Model has five (5) different ballot types. Stakeholders can only claim one (1) stakeholder status and will be issued one (1) ballot.

1) AREA 1 BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property in Area 1 and who are 18 years or older, can vote for the following races:

- Area 1 Seat Vote for one (1)
- Community Seats Vote for up to fourteen (14)
- Community Interest Community Seat Vote for one (1)

2) AREA 2 BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property in Area 2 and who are 18 years or older, can vote for the following races:

- Area 2 Seat Vote for one (1)
- Community Seats Vote for up to fourteen (14)
- Community Interest Community Seat Vote for one (1)

3) AREA 3 BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property in Area 3 and who are 18 years or older, can vote for the following races:

- Area 3 Seat Vote for one (1)
- Community Seats Vote for up to fourteen (14)
- Community Interest Community Seat Vote for one (1)

4) AREA 4 BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property in Area 4 and who are 18 years or older, can vote for the following races:

- Area 4 Seat Vote for one (1)
- Community Seats Vote for up to fourteen (14)
- Community Interest Community Seat Vote for one (1)

5) COMMUNITY INTEREST BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property or who declare a stake in the BHNC and affirm an ongoing and substantial community interest and who are 18 years old or older, can vote for the following race:

Community Interest Community Seat - Vote for one (1)

Summary:

- The BHNC has 19 Board seats. All 19 are elected.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is **18**.
- The BHNC Board has a two-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one Board seat.
