The CHNC Ballot Voting Model has one (1) ballot type.

AT LARGE BOARD MEMBER BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property, own a business, participate in CBOs, faith-based organizations, schools, religious institutions, or other groups or declare a stake and affirm a factual basis for it within the CHNC boundaries can vote for candidates in the following race:

- Directors – Vote for up to five (5)

Summary:

- The CHNC has nine (9) board seats. All nine (9) are elected. Only five (5) will be up for election in 2014 due to staggered board terms.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is **16**.
- The CHNC Board has a staggered, four-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one board seat.
