The ECSEANDC Ballot Voting Model has one (1) ballot type.

AT LARGE BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property or those who declare a stake in the neighborhood and affirm the factual basis for it and who are 18 years or older can vote for the following races:

- Co-Chairperson Vote for one (1)
- Secretary Vote for one (1)
- Neighborhood Representative 1B Vote for one (1)
- Neighborhood Representative 2B Vote for one (1)
- Neighborhood Representative 3B Vote for one (1)

Summary:

- The ECSEANDC has 15 Board seats. Only **nine (9)** are elected. **Five (5)** will be up for election in 2014 due to staggered board terms.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is **18**.
- The ECSEANDC Board has a staggered, four-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one Board seat.
