The EHNC Ballot Voting Model has one (1) ballot type.

EHNC BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work or own property in the neighborhood or who declare a stake in the neighborhood and affirm the factual basis for it and is at least 16 years of age on the day of the election can vote for the following races:

- At-Large Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Neighborhood District 1: Thai Town North Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Neighborhood District 2: Thai Town South Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Neighborhood District 3: Little Armenia West Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Neighborhood District 4: Kingsley Vista Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Neighborhood District 5: Barnsdall Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Neighborhood District 6: Little Armenia East Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Neighborhood District 7: College Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Neighborhood District 8: Northeast Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Neighborhood District 9: Virgil Village North Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Neighborhood District 10: Virgil Village South Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Neighborhood District 11: Four Streets/Dayton Heights Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Tenant Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Property Owner Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Business Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Student Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Community Services Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Youth Representative - Vote for one (1)

Summary:

- The EHNC has 18 board seats. All **18** are elected.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is **16**.
- The EHNC Board has a two-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one board seat.
