Elysian Valley Riverside Neighborhood Council (EVRNC) Ballot Voting Model

The EVRNC Ballot Voting Model has two (2) ballot types. Stakeholders can claim one (1) stakeholder status and will be issued one (1) ballot.

GENERAL BALLOT

Any stakeholder who lives, works or owns property and is at least 16 years of age at the time of the election can vote for the following races:

- At-Large Directors Vote for up to fourteen (14)
- Community Interest Director Vote for one (1)

COMMUNITY INTEREST BALLOT

Stakeholders who declare a stake in the neighborhood and affirm an ongoing and substantial community interest and is at least 16 years of age at the time of the election can vote for the following race:

Community Interest Director - Vote for one (1)

Summary:

- The EVRNC has 15 board seats. All **15** are elected.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is 16.
- The EVRNC Board has a two-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one board seat.
