

Hollywood United Neighborhood Council (HUNC) Ballot Voting Model

The HUNC Ballot Voting Model has one (1) ballot type.

HUNC BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work or own property in the neighborhood and also those who declare a stake in the neighborhood and affirm the factual basis for it can vote for the following races:

- Geographical Area 2 Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Geographical Area 4 Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Business Area B Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Renter Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Homeowner Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Unclassified Stakeholder Status Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Educational Institutions Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Non-Profit Organization Stakeholders Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Faith-Based Organization Representative - Vote for one (1)

Summary:

- The HUNC has 17 board seats. **Seventeen** are elected, but **nine (9)** are up for election due to staggered board seats.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is **16**.
- The HUNC Board has a staggered, four-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one board seat.
- Residential and business districts differ.
