Lake Balboa Neighborhood Council (LBNC) Ballot Voting Model

The LBNC Ballot Voting Model has two (2) ballot types. Stakeholders can only claim one (1) stakeholder status and will be issued one (1) ballot.

1) LAKE BALBOA NC STAKEHOLDER BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property within LBNC or who declare a stake in the neighborhood and affirm a factual basis for it and who are 18 years of age and above can vote for the following races:

- Residential Stakeholder Representatives Vote for up to six (6)
- Business Stakeholder Representatives Vote for up to three (3)
- Organizational Stakeholder Representatives Vote for up to three (3)
- Senior Stakeholder Representative Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Elected Stakeholder Representative Vote for one (1)

2) YOUTH REPRESENTATIVE BALLOT

Stakeholders between the ages of 12 to 18 years of age can vote for the following race:

- Youth Stakeholder Representative – Vote for one (1)

Summary:

- The LBNC has 17 board seats. All **15** are elected.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum voting age is **18**, except for the Youth Representative, which is age 12 to 18.
- The LBNC Board has a two-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one board seat.
