

# Lake Balboa Neighborhood Council (LBNC) Ballot Voting Model

---

The LBNC Ballot Voting Model has two (2) ballot types. Stakeholders can only claim one (1) stakeholder status and will be issued one (1) ballot.

## 1) LAKE BALBOA NC STAKEHOLDER BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property within LBNC or who declare a stake in the neighborhood and affirm a factual basis for it and who are 18 years of age and above can vote for the following races:

- Residential Stakeholder Representatives – Vote for up to six (6)
- Business Stakeholder Representatives – Vote for up to three (3)
- Organizational Stakeholder Representatives – Vote for up to three (3)
- Senior Stakeholder Representative – Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Elected Stakeholder Representative – Vote for one (1)

## 2) YOUTH REPRESENTATIVE BALLOT

Stakeholders between the ages of 12 to 18 years of age can vote for the following race:

- Youth Stakeholder Representative – Vote for one (1)

### Summary:

- The LBNC has 17 board seats. All **15** are elected.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum voting age is **18**, except for the Youth Representative, which is age 12 to 18.
- The LBNC Board has a two-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one board seat.
