Community stakeholders who live, work, own a property or business or who declare a stake in the neighborhood and affirm a factual basis for it who are 13 years or older, can vote for the following races:

- Vice-President - Vote for one (1)
- Treasurer - Vote for one (1)
- Business Community Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Community Based Organizations Representatives - Vote for up to two (2)
- Youth Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Sub-Area 2 Representative Resident Seat - Vote for one (1)
- Sub-Area 4 Representative Resident Seat - Vote for one (1)
- Sub-Area 6 Representative Resident Seat - Vote for one (1)
- Sub-Area 1 Representative At-Large Seat - Vote for one (1)
- Sub-Area 3 Representative At-Large Seat - Vote for one (1)
- Sub-Area 5 Representative At-Large Seat - Vote for one (1)
- Sub-Area 7 Representative At-Large Seat - Vote for one (1)


## Summary:

- The LHNC has 26 Board seats. All 26 are elected. Only 13 will be up for election in 2014 due to staggered four-year terms.
- Stakeholders will use Documentation as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is 13.
- The LHNC Board has a staggered, four-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one Board seat.
