The LFNC Ballot Voting Model has five (5) ballot types. Stakeholders can claim one (1) stakeholder status and will be issued one (1) ballot.

DISTRICT A REPRESENTATIVE BALLOT

Stakeholders who are at least thirteen (13) years of age at the time of the election who live, work or own real property in District A and also those who declare a stake in District A as a community interest stakeholder, defined as a person who affirms a substantial and ongoing participation within the District A boundaries and who may be in a community organization such as, but not limited to, educational, non-profit and/or religious organizations can vote for the following races:

- District A Representative Vote for one (1)
- Community Interest Representative, Business Vote for one (1)
- Community Interest Representative, Education Vote for one (1)
- Community Interest Representative, Recreation Vote for one (1)
- Community Interest Representative, Public Safety Vote for one (1)

DISTRICT B REPRESENTATIVE BALLOT

DISTRICT E REPRESENTATIVE BALLOT

Stakeholders who are at least thirteen (13) years of age at the time of the election who live, work or own real property in District E and also those who declare a stake in District E as a community interest stakeholder, defined as a person who affirms a substantial and ongoing participation within the District E boundaries and who may be in a community organization such as, but not limited to, educational, non-profit and/or religious organizations can vote for the following races:

- District E Representative Vote for one (1)
- Community Interest Representative, Business Vote for one (1)
- Community Interest Representative, Education Vote for one (1)
- Community Interest Representative, Recreation Vote for one (1)
- Community Interest Representative, Public Safety Vote for one (1)

Summary:

- The LFNC has 19 board seats, but only **nine** (9) seats will be up for election due to staggered board terms.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is **13**.
- The LFNC Board has a staggered four-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one board seat.
