The MPNC Ballot Voting Model has one (1) ballot.

GENERAL BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work or own real property in the neighborhood and also those who declare a stake in the neighborhood as a community interest stakeholder, defined as a person who affirms a substantial and ongoing participation within the neighborhood council's boundaries and who may be in a community organization such as, but not limited to, educational, non-profit and/or religious organizations, and who are 16 years or older can vote for the following races:

- District 1 Residential Representative Vote for one (1)
- District 2 Residential Representative Vote for one (1)
- District 3 Residential Representative Vote for one (1)
- District 4 Residential Representative Vote for one (1)
- District 5 Residential Representative Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Stakeholder Representatives Vote for up to twelve (12)

Summary:

- The MPNC has 17 board seats. All **17** are elected.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is 16.
- The MPNC Board has a four-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one Board seat.
