Mission Hills Neighborhood Council (MHNC) Ballot Voting Model

The MHNC Ballot Voting Model has one (1) ballot type.

1) GENERAL BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work or own property in the neighborhood and also those who declare a stake in the neighborhood and affirm the factual basis for it who are 18 years or older can vote for the following races:

- At-Large Director Vote for one (1)
- Residential Homeowner Directors Vote for up to three (3)
- Residential Renter Director Vote for one (1)
- Business Owner Director Vote for one (1)

Summary:

- The MHNC has 14 board seats. All 14 are elected. **Six** (6) will be up for election in 2014 due to staggered board terms.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is 18.
- The MHNC Board has a staggered four-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one board seat.
