## North Hills East Neighborhood Council (NHENC) Ballot Voting Model

The NHENC Ballot Voting Model has two (2) ballot types. Stakeholders can claim one (1) stakeholder status and will be issued one (1) ballot.

## 1) GENERAL BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, or own property within the NHENC boundaries and are at least 14 years of age can vote for the following races:

- Homeowner Board Member Vote for one (1)
- Renter Stakeholder Board Member Vote for one (1)
- Business Owner Stakeholder Board Member Vote for one (1)
- Employee Stakeholder Board Member Vote for one (1)
- Organizational Board Member Vote for one (1)
- Youth Community Board Member Vote for one (1)
- Senior Citizen Community Board Member Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Stakeholder Board Members Vote for up to four (4)
- Region 1 Stakeholder Board Member Vote for one (1)
- Region 2 Stakeholder Board Member Vote for one (1)
- Region 3 Stakeholder Board Member Vote for one (1)
- Region 4 Stakeholder Board Member Vote for one (1)

## 2) FACTUAL BASIS BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, or own property or declare a stake within the NHENC boundaries and affirm a factual basis for it and are at least 14 years of age can vote for the following races:

- Organizational Board Member Vote for one (1)
- Youth Community Board Member Vote for one (1)
- Senior Citizen Community Board Member Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Stakeholder Board Members Vote for up to four (4)

## Summary:

- The NHENC has 15 board seats. All **15** are elected.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is 14.
- The NHENC board has a two-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one board seat.
