North Hills West Neighborhood Council (NHWNC) Ballot Voting Model

The NHWNC Ballot Voting Model has three (3) ballot types. Stakeholders can claim one (1) stakeholder status and will be issued one (1) ballot.

1) RESIDENTIAL STAKEHOLDER BOARD MEMBERS BALLOT

Stakeholders who reside within the NHWNC and who are 18 years or older can vote for the following races:

- Residential Stakeholder Board Members Vote for up to seven (7)
- General Stakeholder Board Members Vote for up to five (5)
- Factual Basis Stakeholder Board Member Vote for one (1)

2) GENERAL STAKEHOLDER BOARD MEMBERS BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, or own property in the NHWNC Boundaries who are 18 years or older can vote for the following race:

- General Stakeholder Board Members Vote for up to five (5)
- Factual Basis Stakeholder Board Member Vote for one (1)

3) FACTUAL BASIS STAKEHOLDER BOARD MEMBERS BALLOT

Stakeholders who declare a stake and affirm a factual basis within the NHWNC Boundaries and who are 18 years and older can vote for the following race:

- Factual Basis Stakeholder Board Member - Vote for one (1)

Summary:

- The NHWNC has 13 board seats. All **13** are elected.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is **18**.
- The NHWNC board has a two-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one board seat.
