

Olympic Park Neighborhood Council (OPNC) Ballot Voting Model

The OPNC Ballot Voting Model has one (1) ballot type.

GENERAL BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work or own property in the neighborhood and also those who declare a stake in the neighborhood and affirm the factual basis for it and who are 16 years of age can vote for the following races:

- West Area Representatives - Vote for up to six (6)
- East Area Representatives - Vote for up to six (6)
- Youth Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Senior Citizen Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Community-Based Organization Representatives - Vote for up to two (2)
- School Community Representatives - Vote for up to two (2)
- At-Large Representative - Vote for one (1)

Summary:

- The OPNC has 19 Board seats. All **19** are elected.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is **16**.
- The OPNC Board has a two-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one Board seat.
