## Olympic Park Neighborhood Council (OPNC) Ballot Voting Model

The OPNC Ballot Voting Model has one (1) ballot type.

## **GENERAL BALLOT**

Stakeholders who live, work or own property in the neighborhood and also those who declare a stake in the neighborhood and affirm the factual basis for it and who are 16 years of age can vote for the following races:

- West Area Representatives Vote for up to six (6)
- East Area Representatives Vote for up to six (6)
- Youth Representative Vote for one (1)
- Senior Citizen Representative Vote for one (1)
- Community-Based Organization Representatives Vote for up to two (2)
- School Community Representatives Vote for up to two (2)
- At-Large Representative Vote for one (1)

## **Summary:**

- The OPNC has 19 Board seats. All 19 are elected.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is 16.
- The OPNC Board has a two-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one Board seat.
