

# Park Mesa Heights Neighborhood Council (PMHNC) Ballot Voting Model

The PMHNC Ballot Voting Model has one (1) ballot type.

## **GENERAL BALLOT**

Community stakeholders who live, work or own property, or affirm a substantial and ongoing participation within the neighborhood council's boundaries and who are 14 years of age at the time of the election can vote for the following races:

- Vice-President - Vote for one (1)
- Secretary - Vote for one (1)
- Sergeant-At-Arms - Vote for one (1)
- Parliamentarian - Vote for one (1)
- Youth/Educational Representative - Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Representative - Vote for one (1)
- View Heights Resident Representative - Vote for one (1)

## **Summary:**

- The PMHNC has 15 board seats. All **15** are elected, but only **seven (7)** seats will be up for election in 2014 due to staggered board terms.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is **14**.
- The PMHNC Board has a staggered, four-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one board seat.
