The PNC Ballot Voting Model has one (1) ballot type.

GENERAL BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property or declare a stake within the PNC boundaries and are at least 14 years if age can affirm a factual basis for it can vote for the following races:

- Youth Representatives Vote for up to three (3)
- Seniors Representatives Vote for up to three (3)
- Renters Representatives Vote for up to four (4)
- Home/Condo Owner Representatives Vote for up to four (4)
- Retail Business Representatives Vote for up to two (2)
- Industrial Business Representatives Vote for up to two (2)
- Community Based Organization Representative Vote for one (1)
- Faith-based Organization Representative Vote for one (1)
- School Representative Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Representatives Vote for up to two (2)

Summary:

- The PNC has 23 board seats. All **23** are elected.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is **14**.
- The PNC has no voting districts within their boundaries.
- The PNC Board has a two-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one board seat.
