

# Panorama City Neighborhood Council (PCNC) Ballot Voting Model

---

The PCNC Ballot Voting Model has two (2) ballot types. Stakeholders can claim one (1) stakeholder status and will be issued one (1) ballot. A factual basis stakeholder can only vote for one race.

## 1) GENERAL BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, or own property within the council boundaries and who are at least 18 years of age on the day of the election can vote for the following races:

- Resident-Homeowner North Director - Vote for one (1)
- Resident-Homeowner Center-West Director - Vote for one (1)
- Resident-Homeowner Center-East Director - Vote for one (1)
- Resident-Renter Southwest Director - Vote for one (1)
- Resident-Renter Southeast Director - Vote for one (1)
- Business Directors - Vote for up to three (3)
- At-Large Directors - Vote for up to two (2)
- Unlimited At-Large Director - Vote for up to one (1)

## 2) FACTUAL BASIS BALLOT

Factual basis stakeholders who are at least 18 years of age on the day of the election can only vote in the following race:

- Unlimited At-Large Director - Vote for one (1)

## Summary:

- The PCNC has 21 board seats. All 21 are elected, but only **11** will be up for election in 2014 due to staggered board terms.
- Stakeholders will use **documentation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is **18**.
- The PCNC Board has staggered, four year terms.
- Candidates can run for no more than one board seat.
