Pico Union Neighborhood Council (PUNC) Ballot Voting Model

The PUNC Ballot Voting Model has one (1) ballot type.

GENERAL BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property or those who declare a stake within the PUNC boundaries and affirm a factual basis for it and who are 16 or older can vote in the following races:

- Senior Citizen Representative Vote for one (1)
- Community Based Organization Representatives Vote for up to three (3)
- Resident Homeowner Representative Vote for one (1)
- Business Representative Vote for one (1)
- Resident Tenant Representative Vote for one (1)

Summary:

- The PUNC has 15 Board seats. **Fifteen** are elected, but only **seven (7)** seats will be up for election in 2014 due to staggered board terms.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is 16.
- The PUNC Board has a staggered, four-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one Board seat.
