

# South Central Neighborhood Council (SCNC) Ballot Voting Model

---

The SCNC Ballot Voting Model has one (1) ballot type.

## 1) GENERAL BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, or own property in the neighborhood and also those who declare a stake in the SCNC and affirm the factual basis for it and who are 18 years or older can vote for the following race:

- President - Vote for one (1)
- Vice President - Vote for one (1)
- Secretary - Vote for one (1)
- Treasurer - Vote for one (1)
- Parliamentarian - Vote for one (1)

### Summary:

- The SCNC has 9 Board seats. All **nine (9)** are elected. **Five (5)** will be up for election in 2014 due to staggered board terms.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is **18**.
- The SCNC Board has a staggered, four-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one (1) Board seat.
