

South Robertson Neighborhoods Council (SORONC) Ballot Voting Model

The SORONC Ballot Voting Model has two ballot (2) ballot types. Stakeholders can only claim one (1) stakeholder status and will be issued one (1) ballot.

SORONC BALLOT

Any Stakeholder who lives, works or owns property in the neighborhood, who is at least 15 years of age at the time of the election, can vote for the following races:

- Resident Zone 2 Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Resident Zone 4 Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Resident Zone 6 Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Resident Zone 8 Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Resident Zone 10 Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Business Representatives - Vote for up to three (3)
- Organization Representatives - Vote for up to three (3)
- At-Large Representatives - Vote for up to three (3)
- School 1 Representative - Vote for one (1)

AT-LARGE BALLOT

Any Stakeholder who is at least 15 years of age at the time of the election, including but not limited to, factual basis stakeholders, can vote for the following races:

- At-Large Representatives - Vote for up to three (3)

Summary:

- The SORONC has 25 Board seats. **Twenty-four** are elected, but only **15** will be up for election in 2014 due to staggered board terms.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is **15**.
- The SORONC Board has a staggered, four-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one Board seat.
