

Sherman Oaks Neighborhood Council (SONC) Ballot Voting Model

The SONC Ballot Voting Model has six (6) different ballot types. Stakeholders can only claim one (1) stakeholder status and will be issued one (1) ballot.

1) GEOGRAPHIC AREA 2 BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, or own property in Geographic Area 2 and who are 18 years or older can vote for the following races:

- Area 2 Residential Stakeholder Member - Vote for one (1)
- Area 2 Business Stakeholder Member - Vote for one (1)
- Area 2 Community Interest Stakeholder Member - Vote for one (1)

2) GEOGRAPHIC AREA 4 BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, or own property in Geographic Area 4 and who are 18 years or older can vote for the following races:

- Area 4 Residential Stakeholder Member - Vote for one (1)
- Area 4 Business Stakeholder Member - Vote for one (1)
- Area 4 Community Interest Stakeholder Member - Vote for one (1)

3) GEOGRAPHIC AREA 6 BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, or own property in Geographic Area 6 and who are 18 years or older can vote for the following races:

- Area 6 Residential Stakeholder Member - Vote for one (1)
- Area 6 Business Stakeholder Member - Vote for one (1)
- Area 6 Community Interest Stakeholder Member - Vote for one (1)

4) GEOGRAPHIC AREA 2 COMMUNITY INTEREST BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property or declare a stake in Geographic Area 2 and affirm the factual basis for it and who are 18 years or older can vote for the following race:

- Area 2 Community Interest Stakeholder Member - Vote for one (1)

5) GEOGRAPHIC AREA 4 COMMUNITY INTEREST BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property or declare a stake in Geographic Area 4 and affirm the factual basis for it and who are 18 years or older can vote for the following race:

- Area 4 Community Interest Stakeholder Member - Vote for one (1)

6) GEOGRAPHIC AREA 6 COMMUNITY INTEREST BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property or declare a stake in Geographic Area 6 and affirm the factual basis for it and who are 18 years or older can vote for the following race:

- Area 6 Community Interest Stakeholder Member - Vote for one (1)

Summary:

- The SONC has 21 board seats. **Twenty-one** are elected, but only **nine (9)** will be up for election in 2014 due to staggered four-year terms.
- Stakeholders will use **documentation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is **18**.
- The SONC board has staggered, four-year terms.
- Candidates can run for no more than one board seat.
