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REASON FOR CHALLENGE:	ADA/Curbside voting compliance
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Please state the facts for your challenge. (max 500 words)	Several Silver Lake Stakeholders, who were desirous of voting in the Silver Lake Neighborhood Council, were denied that right because the required curb side voting was not made available and/or poorly staffed. This lack of compliance denied a certain sector of Silver Lake their right to vote without placing an undue burden on themselves and/or their caregivers. This disregard to our older stakeholders or those who need the security and convenience of curb side/ADA compliant voting is considered voter suppression. With the amount of time, money and energy supposedly spent of outreach, to forget the special needs of these residents gives the impression of disregard the disrespect for certain Silver Lake residents.
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Please state your desired remedy. (max 100 words)	The Elections Manual is clear on this issue. On page 223 of the Manual, under the list of challengeable offenses, "Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Accessible Facility (if curbside voting was not available). Although it was stated that curb side voting would be made available during the SLNC elections, several voters were denied their right to vote because of the lack staff or availability of curb side voting. These voters should be given the opportunity to cast their votes.
