

Sylmar Neighborhood Council (SNC) Ballot Voting Model

The SNC Ballot Voting Model has one (1) ballot type.

GENERAL BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property or declare a stake within the SNC boundaries and affirm a factual basis for it can vote for the following races:

- Youth Representative – Vote for one (1)
- Senior Representative – Vote for one (1)
- Recreation/Open Spaces Representative – Vote for one (1)
- Equestrian Representative – Vote for one (1)
- Retail Representatives – Vote for up to three (3)
- Industrial Representative – Vote for one (1)
- Home/Condo Owner Representatives – Vote for up to four (4)
- Renter Representatives – Vote for up to (2)
- Community Based Organization Representatives – Vote for up to two (2)
- Faith Based Organization Representative – Vote for one (1)
- Educational Institution Representative – Vote for one (1)
- At Large Representatives – Vote for up to three (3)

Summary:

- The SNC has 21 board seats. All **21** are elected.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is **14**.
- The SNC has no voting districts within their boundaries.
- The SNC Board has a two-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one board seat.
