## Neighborhood Council Valley Village (NCVV) Ballot Voting Model

The NCVV Ballot Voting Model has one (1) ballot type.

1) NCVV BALLOT

Stakeholders who either live, work or own property in the Valley Village neighborhood and who are 18 years or older, can vote for the following races:

- Homeowner Seats "A" Representatives - Vote for up to two (2)
- Residential Renter Seats "A" Representatives - Vote for up to two (2)
- Business Seat "A" Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Faith Based Seat Representative - Vote for one (1)
- Community Service Based Seat Representative - Vote for one (1)
- At Large Seat "A" Representative - Vote for one (1)


## Summary:

- The NCVV has 15 Board seats. Fifteen are elected, but only eight (8) will be up for election in 2014 due to staggered four-year terms.
- Stakeholders will use Documentation as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is 18.
- The NCVV Board has a staggered, four-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one Board seat.
