

Van Nuys Neighborhood Council (VNNC) Ballot Voting Model

The VNNC Ballot Voting Model has one (1) ballot type.

AT LARGE BALLOT

Stakeholders who live, work, own property or declare a stake within the VNNC and affirm a factual basis for it and who are 18 years or older, can vote for the following races:

- Resident Representative Zone 2 - Vote for one (1)
- Resident Representative Zone 4 - Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Resident Representative Seat 2 - Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Residential Renter Representative Seat 2 - Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Industrial Business Owner or Employee Representative Seat 2 - Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Commercial Business Owner or Employee Representative Seat 2 - Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Commercial Business Owner or Employee Representative Seat 4 - Vote for one (1)
- Non-Profit Community Based Organizations or Service Clubs Representative Seat 2 - Vote for one (1)
- School Representative - Vote for one (1)
- At-Large Representative - Vote for one (1)

Summary:

- The VNNC has 21 Board seats. **Twenty-one** are elected, but only **10** will be up for election in 2014 due to staggered board terms.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is **18**.
- The VNNC Board has staggered, four-year terms.
- Candidates can run for no more than one Board seat.
