

# Westlake North Neighborhood Council (WNNC) Ballot Voting Model

---

The WNNC Ballot Voting Model has two (2) ballot types.

## 1) GENERAL BALLOT

Stakeholders 16 years of age and above who live, work, or own property in the neighborhood can vote for the following races:

- Resident Stakeholder Board Members - Vote for three (3)
- Business Stakeholder Board Members - Vote for two (2)
- Community Organization Stakeholder Board Members - Vote for three (3)
- Senior Stakeholder Board Member - Vote for one (1)
- Youth Board Members - Vote for two (2)
- At-Large Stakeholder Board Members - Vote for four (4)

## 2) FACTUAL BASIS BALLOT

Stakeholders 16 years of age and above who live, work, or own property in the neighborhood and also those who declare a stake in the neighborhood and affirm the factual basis for it can vote for the following race:

- At-Large Stakeholder Board Members - Vote for four (4)

## Summary:

- The WNNC has 15 Board seats. All **15** are elected.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is **16**.
- The WNNC Board has a two-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one Board seat.
