Westlake North Neighborhood Council (WNNC) Ballot Voting Model

The WNNC Ballot Voting Model has two (2) ballot types.

1) GENERAL BALLOT

Stakeholders 16 years of age and above who live, work, or own property in the neighborhood can vote for the following races:

- Resident Stakeholder Board Members Vote for three (3)
- Business Stakeholder Board Members Vote for two (2)
- Community Organization Stakeholder Board Members Vote for three (3)
- Senior Stakeholder Board Member Vote for one (1)
- Youth Board Members Vote for two (2)
- At-Large Stakeholder Board Members Vote for four (4)

2) FACTUAL BASIS BALLOT

Stakeholders 16 years of age and above who live, work, or own property in the neighborhood and also those who declare a stake in the neighborhood and affirm the factual basis for it can vote for the following race:

At-Large Stakeholder Board Members - Vote for four (4)

Summary:

- The WNNC has 15 Board seats. All **15** are elected.
- Stakeholders will use **self-affirmation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is **16**.
- The WNNC Board has a two-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one Board seat.
