Westlake South Neighborhood Council (WSNC) Ballot Voting Model

The WSNC Ballot Voting Model has two (2) ballot types.

1) GENERAL BALLOT

Stakeholders 18 years of age and above who live, work, or own property in the neighborhood can vote for the following races:

- Resident Stakeholder Board Members Vote for four (4)
- Business Stakeholder Board Members Vote for four (4)
- Community-Based Organizations Board Members Vote for four (4)
- At-Large Stakeholder Board Members Vote for three (3)

2) FACTUAL BASIS BALLOT

Stakeholders 18 years of age and above who live, work, or own property in the neighborhood and also those who declare a stake in the neighborhood and affirm the factual basis for it can vote for the following race:

- At-Large Stakeholder Board Members - Vote for three (3)

Summary:

- The WSNC has 15 Board seats. All 15 are elected.
- Stakeholders will use **documentation** as a means of establishing their stakeholder status.
- Minimum stakeholder voting age is 18.
- The WSNC Board has a two-year term.
- Candidates can run for no more than one Board seat.
