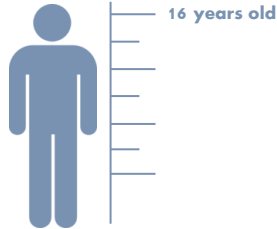

## WHAT DO THEY DO



Poll workers help organize the election polls in many ways:



**Help set up  
tables, booths  
and signs**

**Challenge a voter on the following grounds:**

- Person is listed as a VBM Voter who has already voted
- The person is not a Voter as defined in the Neighborhood Council Bylaws
- The person is not the person he/she claims to be
- Person has already voted that day



**Help resolve challenges:**

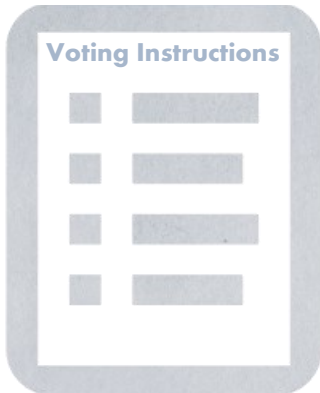
Allow Provisional Voting

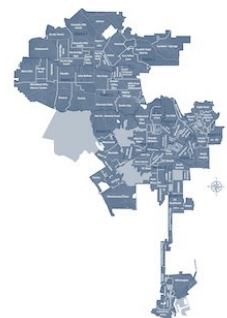
