Re: Procedure for Requesting Legal Advice from the Office of the City Attorney

Dear Neighborhood Council Board Members,

I hope this letter finds you well. Thank you for your efforts toward improving your communities and volunteering for the Neighborhood Council system. The purpose of this letter is to introduce board members to our legal team and explain the process for seeking legal advice from our Office.

The Neighborhood Council Advice Division Attorneys

The Neighborhood Council Advice Division provides legal advice to Neighborhood Councils, the Board of Neighborhood Commissioners, the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment the City Clerk and all City Officials and agencies on issues related to Neighborhood Councils. The Division Attorneys provide advice on the Brown Act, Public Records Act, Conflict of Interest, contracts, leases and any other laws impacting Neighborhood Councils.

The Regional Attorneys assigned to advise the Neighborhood Councils are Deputy City Attorney Carmen D. Hawkins and Deputy City Attorney Elise Ruden. Please see the attached "City Attorney Certified Neighborhood Council Assignments" for each attorney's assignments. Deputy City Attorneys Carmen D. Hawkins and Elise Ruden bring over 60 years of legal experience in the City Attorney's Office to assist your board with its operations and are experienced in a myriad of civil and criminal matters.

Requests for Legal Advice

Due to our limited resources, we are unable to respond to the numerous requests for advice that may be sent from board members regarding the board's general operations and procedures. Accordingly, we will only provide general legal advice regarding your board's operations to the Chair/President ("Chair") of your Neighborhood Council.

For example, if a board member (who is not the Chair) has a question about the rules that impact the board's operations or procedures, *e.g.*, the Brown Act, the Public Records Act, the bylaws, *etc.*, then that board member will direct his or her questions to the Chair of the Neighborhood Council. The Chair will ask the assigned Regional Attorney for their board the question and the assigned Regional Attorney will respond to the Chair. The Chair will then disseminate our advice to his or her fellow board members. If a board member has not gone through the Chair to request general legal advice, then we will refer that board member back to the Chair. If there is no Chair or the Chair is unable to serve in this function, then our Office will select another board member to serve as the person who may seek general legal advice on behalf of the board.

If a board member has a question about a personal conflict of interest on a matter that may be coming before their Neighborhood Council, then the board member with the conflict may directly contact the assigned Regional Attorney for their Neighborhood Council. Deputy City Attorney Carmen Hawkins may be reached at carmen.hawkins@lacity.org and Deputy City Attorney Elise Ruden may be reached at elise.ruden@lacity.org. Please have the person with the conflict contact us for advice because we must obtain the facts from the person with the conflict in order to provide advice.

In addition, please note that all requests for advice should made in writing, preferably by email. Please include a call back number and the best time to reach you, should we need additional information. Written requests for advice will receive a priority. We attempt to handle each request we receive as soon as possible; however, if you have not received a timely response, please resend your request as a reminder to your Regional Attorney that you need a response.
